### **Emergency Consultation Under Section 7**

### **Definition:**

"Situations involving acts of God, disasters, casualties, national defense or security emergencies, etc."

**Scope of Consultation:** 

Focuses on the agency's response to the emergency, not the emergency itself

**Phases of Emergency Consultation:** 

### Pre-emergency planning

#### Emergency response



### **Pre-planning Phase:**

- Identify contacts
- Setablish roles and responsibilities
- Identify processes
- Develop species maps
- S Establish protective measures
- S Minimize need to make decisions during the emergency

### **Pre-planning Phase Objectives:**

- ID the kinds of emergencies and procedures agencies will use to respond to these emergencies.
- Exchange information on the listed species and critical habitats present in areas and effects of the response activities.
- ID measures agencies can use to avoid, minimize, or mitigate adverse effects to listed species and or areas of designated critical habitat.

### **Emergency Response Phase:**

- Section agency should contact the Services as soon as practicable and identify
  - Iocation of the activity
  - need for the emergency response
  - s any listed resources that may be in the area
  - Gescription of all anticipated activities.

### **Post-Response Phase:**

- Initiate formal consultation if appropriate
- If formal consultation needed, provide:
  - A description of the emergency (provided during the informal consultation phase);
  - A justification for expediting the consultation (provided during the informal consultation phase); and

### **Post-Response Phase (cont.):**

- If formal consultation needed, provide:
  - An evaluation of the emergency and the effects of the response to the emergency on listed species and their habitats
  - A description of how the Services' recommendations (if any) were implemented, and the results of their implementation in terms of minimizing the effects of any take.

### Emergency Consultations (summary)

### Agency responsibilities:

- G do not delay response actions
- Contact the Services when the nature of the emergency is known
- seplain why it is an emergency
- implement, to the degree possible, the Service's initial recommendations
- s after the emergency has ended, continue consultation as appropriate

# Emergency Consultations (summary)

#### Services' responsibilities:

- do not impede response efforts
- establish procedures to define how each office should handle emergencies
- offer recommendations to minimize the effects of the emergency action on the listed species

notify the Federal agency if jeopardy is likely

# Emergency Consultations (summary)

### Services' responsibilities, (cont.):

- follow verbal recommendations with a written document as soon as possible
- notify the Regional Office
- at conclusion of emergency response, complete a Biological Opinion, if necessary
