

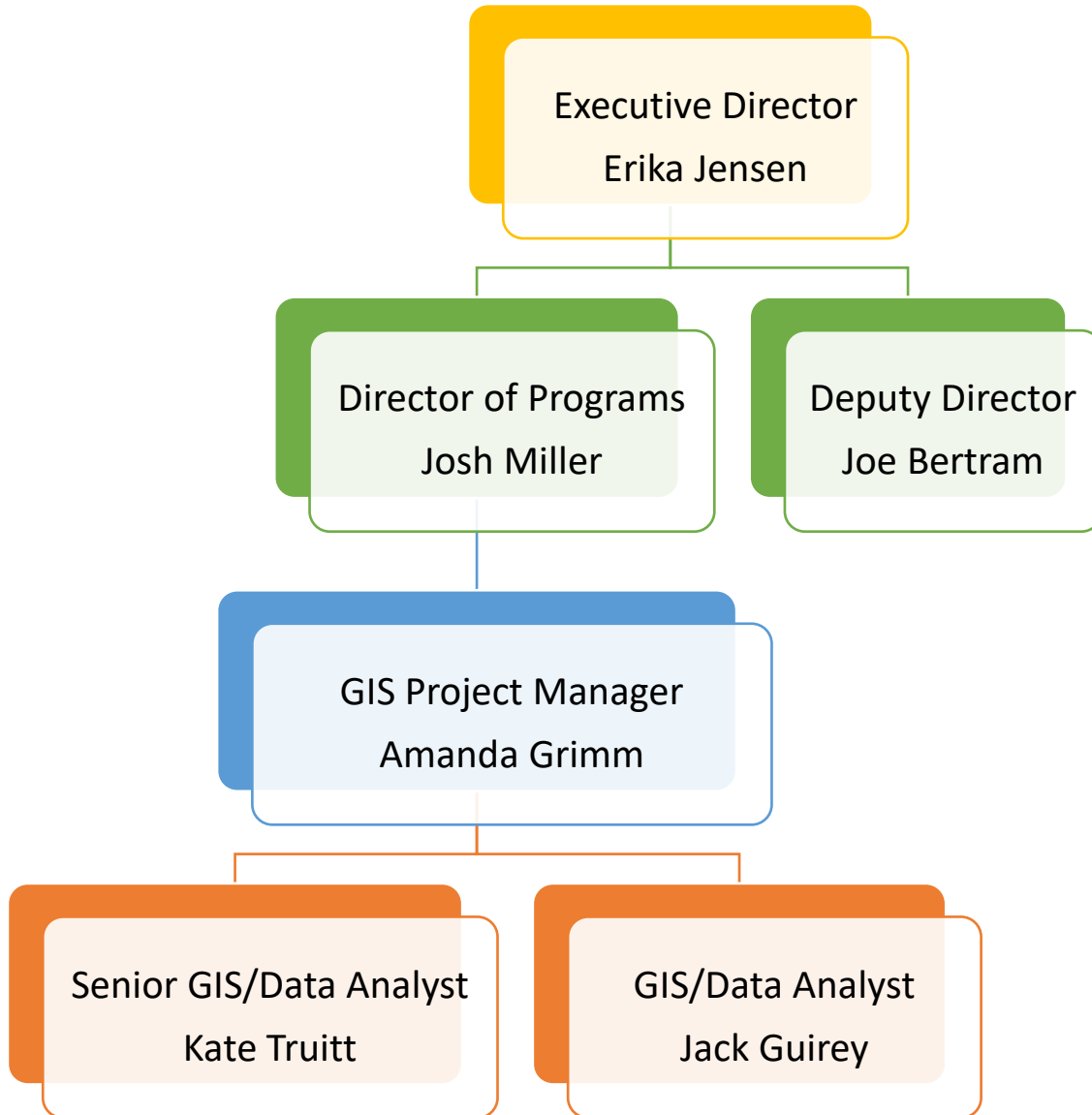

Overview

- The eight Great Lakes states created the Great Lakes Commission (GLC) in 1955 via the Great Lakes Basin Compact. In 1968, Congress provided its consent to the Compact and the GLC, establishing it in both federal and state law.
- The GLC is a binational, nonpartisan agency that brings the region together to work on issues that no entity can tackle alone.
- Core services to our member states and provinces:
 - 1) communications and outreach
 - 2) information management and delivery
 - 3) facilitation and consensus building
 - 4) policy coordination and advocacy
 - 5) regional project management
